

**FIME ENDURO EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP

ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN**

BEFORE THE EVENT

Race Course

The transfer from the paddock area to the special stage will mainly take place on asphalted and unpaved municipal and forest roads, in order to avoid the involvement of natural areas and preserve local biodiversity.

Race course

In particular, the race course will not unfold in any natural area subject to environmental constraints.

The special stages will take place within the area already used by the Organizer for national and regional competitions, without compromising the surrounding environment.

Here below coordinates of special tests:

- **Enduro test 1:** Pietra M.no, Montesambuco GPS (start, finish): Lat. 42°31'35.31" N Long. 15°04'33.61" E.
- **Enduro test 2:** Pietra M.no, Montesambuco GPS (start, finish): Lat. 42°31'37.86" N Long. 15°04'43.99" E., (finis): 42°32'06.44" N Long. 15°04'39.85" E.
- **Cross test:** Pietra M.no, SP. 7 GPS (start and finish): Lat. 42°33'02.79" N Long. 15°09'45.25" E.

In order to protect the environment as much as possible, the streets and areas affected by the race course will be cleaned of garbage accumulated over time and mowing will be carried out along the way where strictly necessary.

Paddock services.

The Paddock and all the central services of the event will be located in Pietramontecorvino - Foggia - Puglia GPS: 41 ° 32'247.00 " N 15 ° 08'51.27 " E.

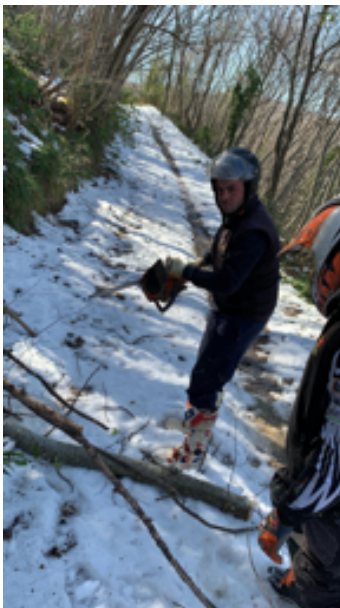
Special spaces have been set up in the paddock area for parking trucks, caravans and vehicles belonging to the various teams and drivers. At the same time, all the equipment necessary for a comfortable stay was made available, given the importance of the international event (toilets, showers and drinking water within the Industrial Area, chemical toilets, electricity, dustbin, baskets for separate waste collection, paper, glass, organic waste and waste oil bins and filters, etc., indicated by panels).

The FAST CAR WASH - Car wash station in C.da Pezza della Chiesa is available for washing motorcycles, located along the provincial road to Lucera about 200 meters from the paddock.

Services in the special stages.

Toilets, containers for unsorted waste and plastic containers have been provided, with the aim of respecting the environment as much as possible.

The Organizer, in agreement with the local authorities, manages the cleaning of the pedestrian, cycle and motorcycle routes in the area.



DURING THE EVENT

Control in the Paddock Area.

During the competition, the paddock will be monitored in order to check that the teams respect the rules of the FIME environmental code.

Special Test and Parking Area

The organizer in collaboration with the Municipal Police, the Civil Protection of Pietra M.no and Casalnuovo M.ro and with the various voluntary associations will be present on the competition field, in the paddock area and along the provincial roads to ensure maximum safety for pilots and teams.

Environmental Mats

It is mandatory for each rider to use the environmental mat for the repair and operation of their motorcycles. It is also compulsory to use it in the Parc Ferme.

AFTER THE RACE

Cleaning of areas

At the end of the event, the organizer will clean the race course and collect all the material used for the race (poles, ribbons, posters, banners, etc.). At the same time, all containers and baskets will be recovered. In the same way we will proceed in the paddock.

Control Check

A few weeks after the end of the race, the managers of the motorcycle club and the administrative managers of the municipalities involved will carry out a visit to the race course, in order to assess the state of the ground after the race. If necessary, the organization will take steps to restore the state of the soils as quickly as possible.

Photo Monitoring.

In order to monitor the environmental impact that the organization may have on nature, a photographic dossier of the areas will be drawn up. This photographic dossier will continue to be carried out for the duration of the competition and after the event for the final evaluation.
