

FIM Europe organises the MINI ENDURO EUROPEAN TROPHY according to the rules of the FIM Europe Sporting Code in addition to the following. The MINIENDURO EUROPEAN TROPHY will consist of one round with two-days of race.

ROUNDS

The overall number of riders in the event must not exceed 200.

PARTICIPATION

Riders must have a valid licence Promotional Continental - Annual or Promotional Continental - One Event.

PRIZES

The prizes will be at discretion of the organizer, but must be a minimum of three in each individual classification. The prize giving will be made in both day, one on Saturday and one on Sunday, at the end of the race.

ENTRY FORM

The entry form shall clearly identify for which class the entry is valid. The entry form may be sent by the promoter online system and must be received 12 days before the event and payment of entry fee must be done 12 days prior to the event.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee per rider is \in 100,00 and must be paid at the latest 12 days before the start of the event to the promoter.

CLASSES

European Trophy classes: • JUNIOR (12-14 years) Capacity 85 cc Wheels: ANT max 19" / POST max 16" • 50 Mini (13-15 years) Capacity 50 cc 2t Wheels: ANT 21" / POST min 18" • 125 MINI (14-16 years) Capacity 125 cc 2t e 4t Wheels: ANT 21" / POST min 18" • WOMAN (12-16 years)

Other open national classes can be run in the same time as European Trophy and will be specified in Supplementary Regulations



CLASS NUMBERS Numbers will be given by the Promoter. The race numbers will be:

European Trophy classes: 125 MINI from 1 50 Mini from 101 JUNIOR from 201 WOMAN from 301

STARTING ORDER For all event of the MiniEnduro European the starting order shall be as follows: European Trophy classes: 125 MINI 50 Mini JUNIOR WOMAN

National classes

Standards of the Races:

- The MINI ENDURO Trophy are composed by 1 event

- The track should have between 15 to 20Km per lap, specials included.

- 2-4 laps/day (total time maximum 4 hours) for European Trophy

- The lap is composed by two or three specials tests Cross Test and Enduro Test, and the track can/should have short-cuts for the beginners.

- The ST should have times between 3 and 7 min.

POINT SCORING

The twenty best riders classified in each will be awarded with points according to the following scale at the end of each day of the competition.

25 points to the 1st 10 points to the 11th 22 points to the 2nd 9 points to the

WINNERS

The winner, the MINIENDURO EUROPEAN TROPHY of a class, or a category, is the rider with the highest number of points. In case of a tie, the rider with the most victories and than highest places in the scoring days will be placed first and so on until the statement is broken. If the draw subsists the winner will be the rider with the higher score in the last day.
